Vinification

It starts with Pinot noir grapes grown in our Grand Cru vineyards in the rolling hills of Monticelli Brusati (Province of Brescia) and then 7 months of the first fermentation in small, stainless steel tanks and oak barrels, then it rests, matures and ages and ferments again on the lees in the bottle for 30 months on average in the darkness and silence of the 15th-century underground corridors of the Castle's historic wine cellar. The magic and romance of Franciacorta, perfectly balancing the naturalness and strength, robustness and complexity of Pinot noir grapes.

Tasting Characteristics

On the palate its fresh and ample flavour combined with excellent body becomes a harmonious blend of savoury and tangy notes, driven by a sweet taste of red fruits. It has a refined elegance and extremely fine evanescence. It has a well-balanced back palate.
