Vinification

Elegant, vigorous and persistent, Monte Zovo's Ripasso della Valpolicella Doc Superiore is the result of the long and accurate productive protocol, invented more than 20 years ago by the Cottini Family. The basis of this process is the careful selection of grapes in the vineyards which are property of the Cottini Family, where only the finest bunches are picked and crushed in the month of September in order to produce a Valpolicella Doc Superiore that stands head and shoulders above the others. Mr. Diego Cottini, winemaker at Monte Zovo then set in motion a particular process that turns this wine into a sophisticated Ripasso, by pouring it onto the skins of the Amarone in January and leaving them together for twenty days.

Tasting Characteristics

Distinctive aromas of dried fruit, ripe fruit and jam that will add body and character.
